

- Absolute Scoring
- Distribution of tasks
- · Lots of technical equipment




CATEGORIES IN SWITZERLAND

With the marks, every judges makes a ranking of all skaters.

Must be able to recognize all jumps, spins and steps and to rate the quality.

CALCULATOR



- Prepares paper work for competition
- · Enters mark into computer
- Computes ranking

CALCULATOR




- Prepares paper work for competition

Must know the rules to be able to make the ranking by hand.



TECHNICAL EQUIPPMENT





Technical Specialist (TS)

- · Says "Start"
- · Calls the elements.
- · Calls the falls.
- Calls review

- Calls the start of the element and at the end calls the level.
- Says "Stop" when the program ends.
- Does not have any paper.







Asistant (AS)

- · Pre-calls the elements.
- Has a copy of the content sheet.
- · Requests a review firstly.

- Writes down all the details of the element.
- Helps to double check the elements inserted in the system.



Controller (CTR)

- · Has a copy of the content sheet.
- Writes down elements.
- Calls review secondly.

- · Times footwork sequence.
- Goes through reviews.
- Checks work of data operator.





JUDGES PANEL



QUALITY OF ELEMENTS (QOE)

- Technical panel scores only the technical value of the element
- Quality is scored by the judges
- Each judge scores each element
- Scores: -3, -2, -1, 0, +1, +2, +3
- Computation done automatically

ARTISTIC IMPRESSION & COMPONENTS

Every judge scores 4 components on a scale from 0.25 to 10 in steps of 0.25.

- Skating skills
- Transitions
- Performance
- Choreography/composition

PREREQUISITES FOR THE ROLES

White System

Judge:

Good roller skating knowledge

Calculator:

- Comfortable user of computer
- Confident handling of numbers

RollArt

Judge:

Good roller skating knowledge

Technical Panel:

- Good roller skating knowledge
- Comfortable with English
- Stress resistant

Calculator:

- Comfortable user of computer (under pressure)
- Comfortable with English
- Stress resistent

CONFLICT OF INTERESTS

A judge must withdraw from a panel if a conflict of interest should arise. A conflict of interest occurs when a judge is assigned to an event in which one or more of the competitors are:

- · A relative.
- A student of a relative.
- · A former student.
- · A former competitive partner.

A two-year period must elapse between skating with a partner, or teaching a pupil, who you are likely to judge.

DUTIES AND PROHIBITIONS OF OFFICIALS

DUTIES

All officials should be present at least half a our before the event starts.

The officials must give their evaluations in accordance with the provisions of the rules to give their scores in accordance with the performances shown.

During figures, the judges must line up separately from each other in such a way that they neither hinder nor favor the skater in the execution of his figures. During the execution of a figure they may change their position if they deem it necessary.

During the free skating competition, the judges will always sit on chairs that are placed at an appropriate distance on one long side.

Each judge keeps a separate record in which he notes his marks, before they are shown. He can also use it to records of the skaters' performances and his corresponding observations, so that he can give explanations about his scores on request. However, such statements should only be made to the the referee or the president of the SRV.

PROHIBITIONS

Any kind of communication is prohibited to the judges. They must give their marks independently of each other.

The judges are not permitted to exchange comments with other persons during the exchange remarks with other persons during the competition or contact them without the consent of the referee.
